Inside The Numbers

Johnson won every statistical category tracked by CompuBox. She was the busier, more accurate fighter, connecting on 50% of her power punches and 38% of her jabs. Johnson also scored the fight's lone knockdown in the fourth round. The referee stopped the lopsided fight two seconds into the ninth round, sparing Metcalf from absorbing more punches, and making Johnson Australia's first undisputed champion.
