## **Inside The Numbers**

Espinoza retained his WBO featherweight title for the fourth time by battering Khegai (23-2-1, won last fight) with his trademark work rate (87.5 punches per round to Khegai's 27.3), close-range uppercuts and industrious jabbing (42.7 attempts/6.8 connects per round compared to Khegai's 8.9/2.5). His attack bloodied Khegai's nose in round four, worsened the cut over his left eye in round six and swelled that eye to the point that the fight was stopped between rounds 10 and 11. Espinoza ended the fight ahead 223-85 overall, 68-25 jabs, 54-48 body, 155-60 power and 10-0 in the CompuBox round-by-round breakdown of total connects, but Khegai was more accurate overall (31%-25%) and in jabs (28%-16%). That said, Espinoza led 35%-33% in power accuracy and the vast output differential proved decisive.
