**Inside The Numbers**

Figueroa threw 190 more punches than Ball, but Ball landed 35 more punches than Figueroa. Ball landed a career high 117 jabs, while Figueroa only landed 37 jabs. Figueroa landed 177 power punches, the most any opponent has ever landed on Ball. 53% of Figueroa's power punch lands were body shots. For the fight, 94 of Figueroa's 214 landed punches were body punches. Figueroa's activity and body punching overcame Ball's activity. In the opening seconds of the final round, Figueroa landed a left hook that sent Ball to the canvas face first. Ball beat the referee's ten count, but he could not protect himself from a final barrage of punches from Figueroa that sent him into the ropes and forced the referee to halt the bout 32 seconds into the twelfth round. Surprisingly, Figueroa was ahead 106-103 on 2 cards, with Ball ahead 107-102 on third card- not surprising.
